## From the Principal and Acting Principal

---

We are delighted to inform you that despite all the challenges for students and staff over the last years, and the uncertainty regarding exams and grade boundaries, Collingwood students achieved some outstanding results this summer. Furthermore, we achieved a strong ALPS progress score of 4 (top 40% progress nationally) for both 'A' level and GCSE levels which is a superb achievement given the context!

All subjects are now being graded on a 9 to 1 scale, where 4 is described as a 'standard pass' and grade 5 is a 'strong pass'.

Like many schools we are calculating our exam statistics using existing benchmarks, where there are agreed equivalents as below:

Grades 9 & 8 are a very challenging standard, and so we are extremely pleased that **35** students secured a grade 9 or 8 in Maths and that there was a total of **60** grade 9 or 8s in English Language and English Literature. There were 5 students who achieved fabulous grade 9s for all three of their Sciences and Maths. **Over 20%** of our students achieved 5 or more top grades (9-7) including English and Maths.

Below is a summary of our students' GCSE achievements in 2023:

- **77%** of all GCSE grades (2756 entries) were at grades 9-4
- **25%** of all GCSE grades (2756 entries) were at grades 9-7
- **12%** of all GCSE grades (2756 entries) were at grades 9-8
- **72%** achieved 5 or more 4+ grades
- **68%** achieved 5 or more 4+ grades including English and Maths
- **50%** achieved a 5+ grade in English and Maths
- **71%** achieved a 4+ grade in English and Maths
- **79%** achieved a 4+ grade in Maths
- **80%** achieved a 4+ in English Language or English Literature
- **71%** achieved a 4+/4-4+ in at least two sciences

Results for the Sixth Form continue to be very strong for grades awarded at A\*-B for A level or Distinction\*/Distinction for BTEC. All the students who wanted a university place were successful. We are also very pleased to support more students to secure places on higher level apprenticeships, as these can be a very attractive alternative for many.

The students who took exams at the end of Year 10 achieved a **97%** pass rate in their GCSE RS short course with **60%** of students gaining a 9-4 grade. We also had 22 students who studied full course RS and **77%** gained a grade 5+ with **over 20%** a top grade.

The students who took a one-year course in Year 9 were rewarded with excellent results too. Consequently, more **than 70%** of the current Year 10 cohort already have a qualification graded 4 or better which bodes well for future examination success!

At Collingwood we are committed to developing responsible, aspirational, independent, happy and well-rounded young people but the curriculum must ensure that all students are able to follow a suitable range of courses so they can enjoy exam success. In 2023 90% of students achieved at least one 9-4 or equivalent grade and almost 50% of students achieved at least one 9-7 or equivalent grade. As parents/carers you will know this represents an incredible amount of hard work and commitment from our staff and students and we are all extremely proud of their achievements in this unprecedented year.

We are driven by our desire to ensure that students leave Collingwood with the appropriate qualifications to access their chosen career path and the personal skills to make a valuable contribution to society. Despite changes to performance league tables, we will continue to maintain a strong focus on maximising the number of students who can pass 5 good GCSE subjects, including English and Maths and 3 A level or BTEC subjects in the Sixth Form and allow students and parents to make the right choices regarding optional subjects.
